

## Income Eligibility Guidelines

**For Title I, the same criteria for identifying low-income students must be used for public and nonpublic school students.** If the district uses income data as of July 1, 2017 the income eligibility guidelines that appear in the chart below would apply. If a district uses data prior to July 1, 2017, then the previous year's income eligibility guidelines would apply.
